This KM explains what to do with the differences in unit of measure (UOM) on the FSS Purchase Order report.

For example, items may have a different UOM from GSA than the UOM the caches issue, such as cartons are ordered from GSA by BD and issued from ICBS as EA.

## **End User Solution**

There are two fields on the Create Inbound Order screen where the appropriate information needs to be entered.

- GSA Order Quantity this is where the GSA quantity in relation to their UOM is entered.
- Cache Order Quantity this is where the cache quantity in relation to their UOM is entered.

See screen shot example for cartons where the GSA order quantity is 1 BD and the cache order quantity is 10 EA.

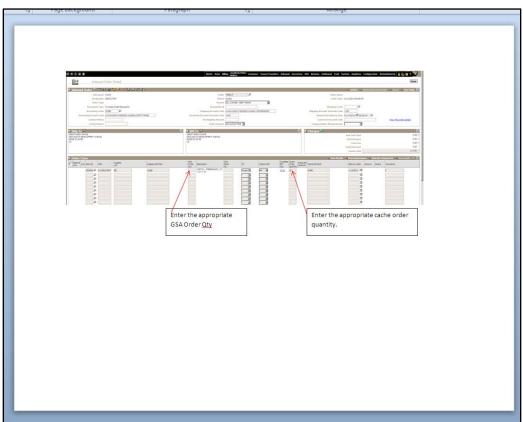


Figure 1: GAS Order Differs From Cache Oder Quantity

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
