Authentication method setup

Add a second layer of security so only you can sign in to your account.

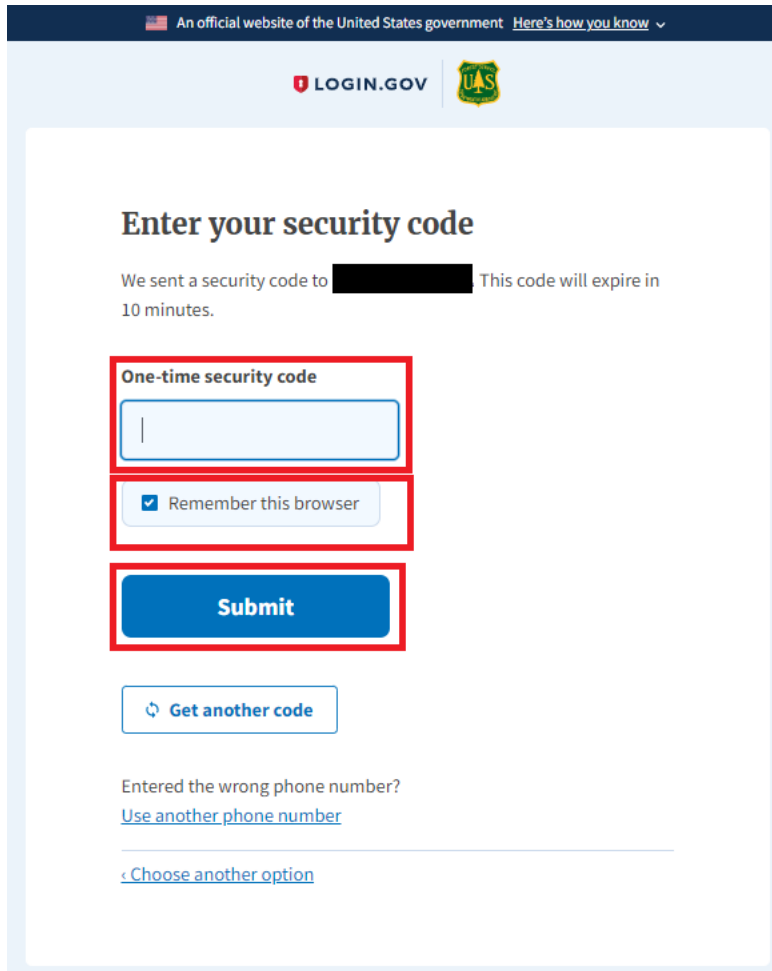

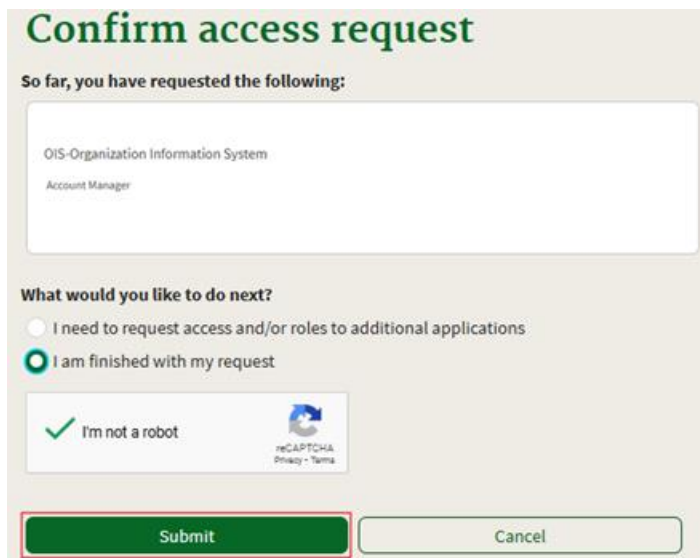

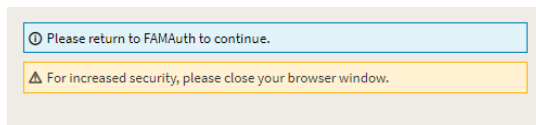
