## Downloading IROC Data File

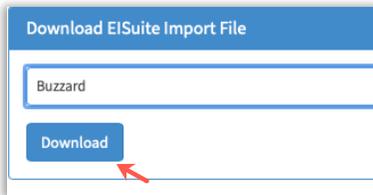
### To Download an IROC Data File

1. Log into **IROC** via the **FAMAuth Portal**: <https://famauth.wildfire.gov>
2. You must have approved access to the **e-ISuite Portal**.
3. Under All Applications scroll down to **EISuite/EISuite Portal**.



*Tip: Click the Star next to EISuite Portal to add to favorites.*

4. Type in the **Incident Name** or **Number**. Select the incident and then click the **Download** button.

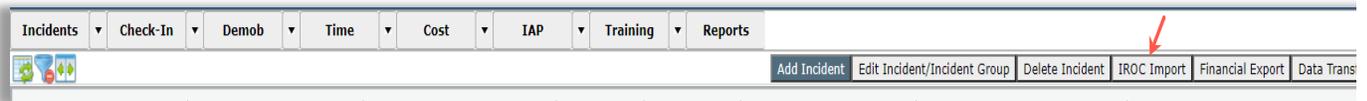


5. It will download to the location specified in your browser settings, i.e. **Downloads** folder.

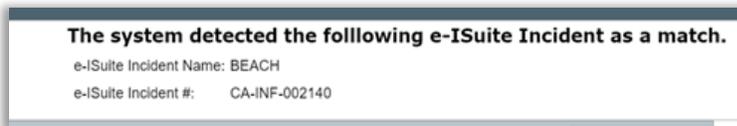
## Importing IROC Data

### To Import an IROC Data File into e-ISuite

1. Open the e-ISuite application and select the **Incidents** button. *Note: User must log in using an account with the Data Steward role.*
2. Click the IROC Import button.



3. Click the magnifying glass to browse for file saved in the IROC download process. Select the file, click **Open** and then click **Start Import**.
4. If the system detected a match between an IROC incident and an e-ISuite incident, the system will display a message indicating the match:

## Importing IROC Data

5. If the system did not detect an incident match, it will be imported as a new incident and the following message will display:

**The system did not detect an e-ISuite Incident match.**

The IROC Incident will be imported as a new Incident.

6. If the system matches an IROC incident with an existing e-ISuite incident, follow the instructions in the next section on '**Matching Resources**'.
7. To exclude resources from the import process, select one or more resources to exclude from the grid on the **Resources** tab. Click the > button to move those resources to the **Exclude from Import** grid. If you need to import the resources at a later date, this can be done using the **Import Excluded Resources** function (see next page).
8. To define an **Incident Jurisdiction** for the incident, select the **Incident Jurisdiction** tab, then select it from the **Jurisdiction** drop-down list.
9. If there are any conflicts detected in the IROC Import file, a **Data Conflicts** tab displays. Select this option and resolve any conflicts by clicking on a conflict and following the instructions on the screen.
10. Click the **Review and Complete** tab to review the import information. Click the **Complete Import** button to complete the IROC Import process.
11. Click the **Incidents** button. On the **Incidents** screen, click on the **Refresh Grid** icon to display the newly imported incident.

## Matching Resources

### To match IROC Resources to e-ISuite Resources

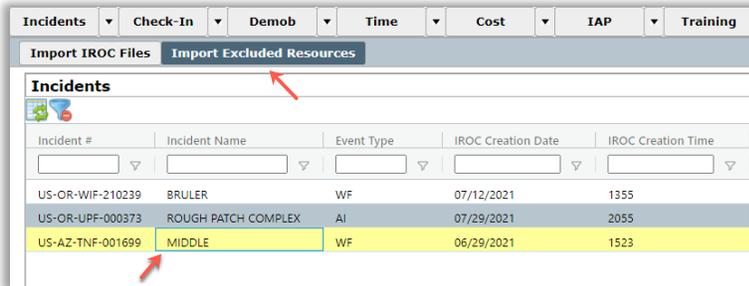
1. If the system matches an e-ISuite Incident to the IROC Import Incident, it may also detect matches in the Resource Data. The system will attempt to match the IROC Resources to the e-ISuite Resources. If the system finds any matches, a **Match Resources** tab will display.

*Note: If the system does not detect any matches, the Match Resources tab will not display.*
2. The first match is by **Request Number and Name**. A list of matches will display on the **Request Number and Name** tab. Review the matches. If a match is not correct, select the match and click the **No Match** button.
3. Select the **Request Number** tab to view a list of matches by **Request Number**. If the match is not correct, select the match and click the **No Match** button.
4. Select the **Resource Name and Item Name** tab to view a list of matches by **Resource Name and Item Name**. If the match is not correct, select the match and click the **No Match** button.
5. Select the **User Matches** tab to review a list of matches that were made by a user. If the match is not correct, select the match and click the **No Match** button.

## Import Excluded Resources

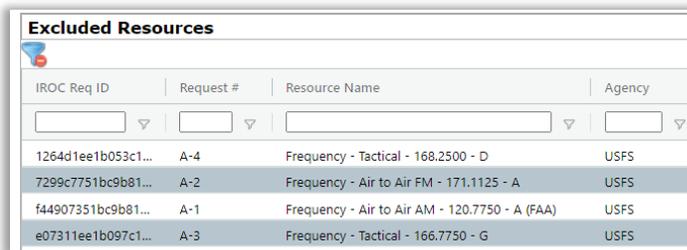
### To Import Excluded Resources

1. Click the **Incidents** button on the **Home** page.
2. Click the **IROC Import** button.
3. Click the **Import Excluded Resources** tab and select an **Incident** listed in the incidents grid.

4. The resources that were excluded for that incident will show in the **Excluded Resources** grid.

5. Select one or more **Excluded Resources** to import in the grid.
6. Click the **Import Resources** button to begin in the process. The **IROC Import** screen will display.
7. Verify the correct resources display on the **New Resources** tab.
8. Click on **Review and Complete**. Review the import information and click the **Complete Import** button to complete the process.
