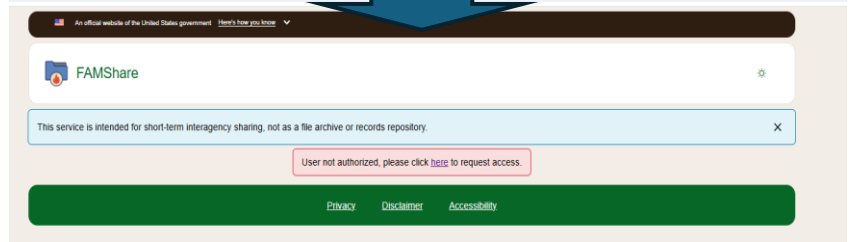
Login.gov is a service that offers secure and private online access to government programs through a Private Non-Federal account.

**Government**

eAuthentication is the system that allows users access to Wildland Fire Apps and Services using government clearance.

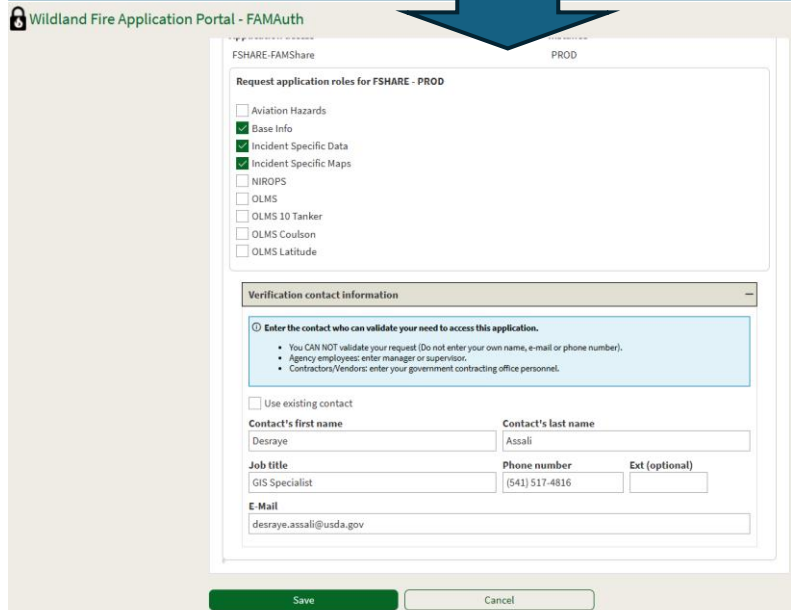
Set up FAMAuth account. You will need an eAuth or login.gov account before creating a FAMAuth account. Note that most federal and state agencies require to have one of these.

I need to **upload and share** incident maps, IAPs, and other files to NIFC File Share site for others to see.



Login to FAMAuth, navigate to FAMShare, request access if you do not have it already.

**Note:** If you previously had access to upload to FireFTP, you were automatically given FAMShare access.



Select which type of data/content you need upload to NIFC Fire Share based on your day job or position you will perform on an incident.

98% of those who need to share/upload to NIFC File Share only need **Incident Specific Data** and **Incident Specific Maps**. **Again, this is only for uploading content.**

Submit FAMShare Request and follow up with an email directed to you [GACC FAMShare Approver\(s\)](#). Include your relevant IQCS Qualifications and/or day job title for access requests.

Once you receive an email stating your access has been changed, login to the FAMShare app. You will login using FAMAuth.

### NIFC File Share Information

Attention, the Authenticated Access area of the NIFC File Share will require authentication via FAMAuth starting May 4, 2026. No action is needed for users that are able to login to FAMAuth using eAuthentication or Login.gov. Users that don't have eAuthentication or Login.gov will need to select Login.gov and create an account.

It is recommended to begin transitioning publicly available files (such as maps, etc) to the Incident Specific Maps area. This area will **not** require authentication after May 4.

Starting May 4 all folders under the Authenticated Access area will require authentication via FAMAuth. In addition, the path to these folders will change. For example, [https://ftp.wildfire.gov/public/incident\\_specific\\_data](https://ftp.wildfire.gov/public/incident_specific_data) changes to [https://ftp.wildfire.gov/protected/incident\\_specific\\_data](https://ftp.wildfire.gov/protected/incident_specific_data). Bookmarks and QR codes to these folders will need to be updated as a result. The path for the Incident Specific Maps folder will **not** change.

Welcome to the **NIFC File Share**, an official site for interagency wildland fire incident data and documents. This site is intended for **short-term interagency sharing**, not as a file archive or records repository. There shouldn't be anything data that isn't stored in a safer location, or much data that carries over from season to season.

Many people have access to shared folders, so please retain copies of anything you post.

**Data backups are not performed on the NIFC File Share.**
